EMSA Eastern Division Highlights



- Y-T-D loss of \$445K compared to budgeted loss of \$579K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 51% vs budget of 49%
- Emergency transports are more than budget 1,501 transports or 4%
- Non-emergency transports were 682 more than budget or 11%

EMSA Western Division Highlights



- Y-T-D net loss of \$3,356K compared to budgeted net loss of \$4,256K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 52% compared to budget of 52%
- Emergency transports were more than budget by 1.7% or 699 transports
- Non-emergency transports were less than budget by 14% or 886 transports
