EMSA Eastern Division Highlights



- Y-T-D profit of \$89K compared to budgeted loss of \$1,566K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 53% vs budget of 49%
- Emergency transports are more than budget 2,269 transports or 4.3%
- Non-emergency transports were 1,161 more than budget or 13.7%

EMSA Western Division Highlights



- Y-T-D net loss of \$4,326K compared to budgeted net loss of \$6,904K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 55% compared to budget of 52%
- Emergency transports were more than budget by 1% or 777 transports
- Non-emergency transports were less than budget by 12% or 1,070 transports
