Professional Services Agreement between Oklahoma City and The Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA)

This document details the responsibilities of Oklahoma City as it relates to their collecting and administration of certain utility monies referred to generally as a rate stabilization fund and the obligations of EMSA in return for the receipt of these monies for providing EMS services to Oklahoma City.

This document is the same as the previous year document except for certain dates and dollar amounts reflective of a new fiscal year.
