




Six Month Running Intubation Success Rate










This chart represents that the monthly total of transports to priority two hospitals in the Western Division.


January Priority One Eastern Trauma Transports




January Priority Two Eastern Trauma Transports




January Priority One Trauma Tranport Destination




January Priority Two Western Trauma Transports
