EMSA Eastern Division Highlights



- Y-T-D loss of \$431K compared to budgeted loss of \$143K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 49% vs budget of 49%
- Emergency transports are more than budget 580 transports or 2.7%
- Non-emergency transports were 302 more than budget or 9%

EMSA Western Division Highlights



- Y-T-D net loss of \$2,220K compared to budgeted net loss of \$2,220K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 51% compared to budget of 52%
- Emergency transports were more than budget by .8% or 191 transports
- Non-emergency transports were less than budget by 13% or 481 transports
